for attending the congress

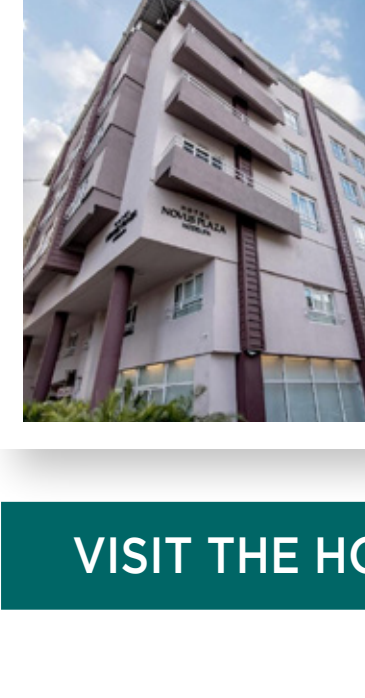

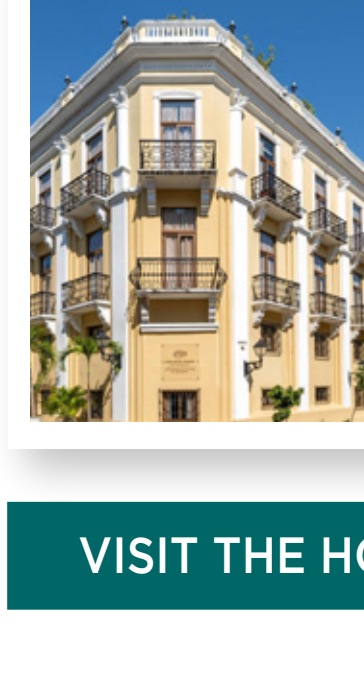

100 m from the meeting point and 10 km from the Botanical Garden.

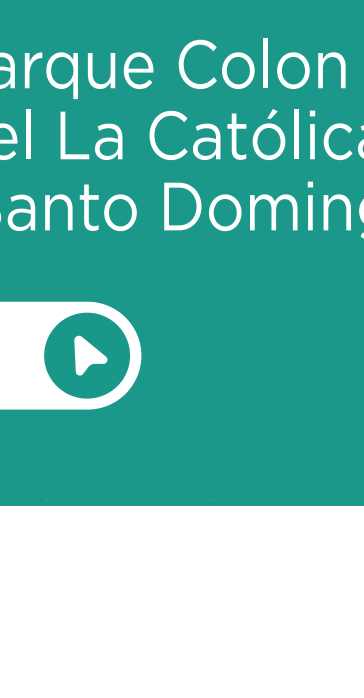

220 m from the meeting point and 10.2 km from the Botanical Garden.

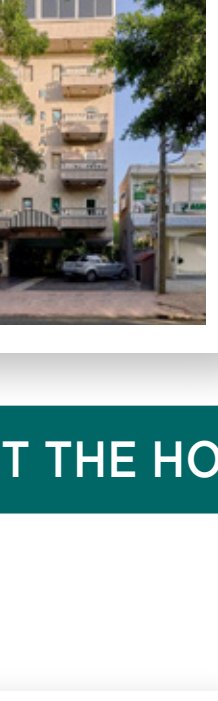

1000 m from the meeting point and 8.9 km from the Botanical Garden.

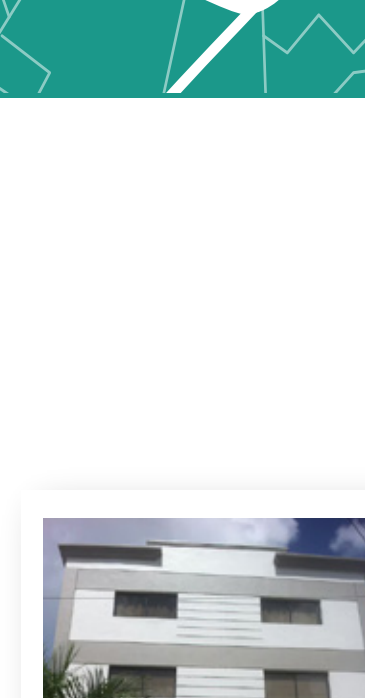

350 m from the meeting point and 9.9 km from the Botanical Garden.

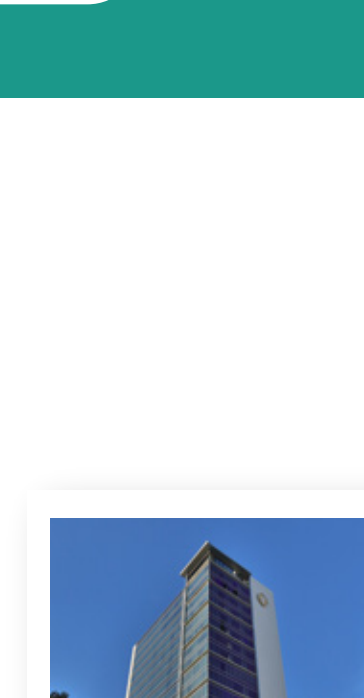

Pick up in front of the hotel and 4.9 km. from the Botanical Garden.

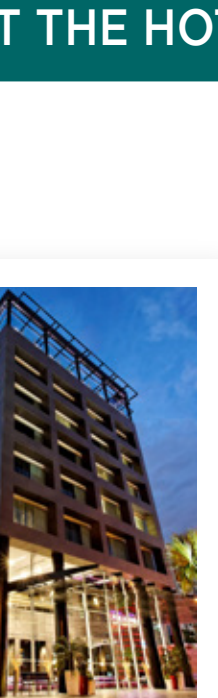

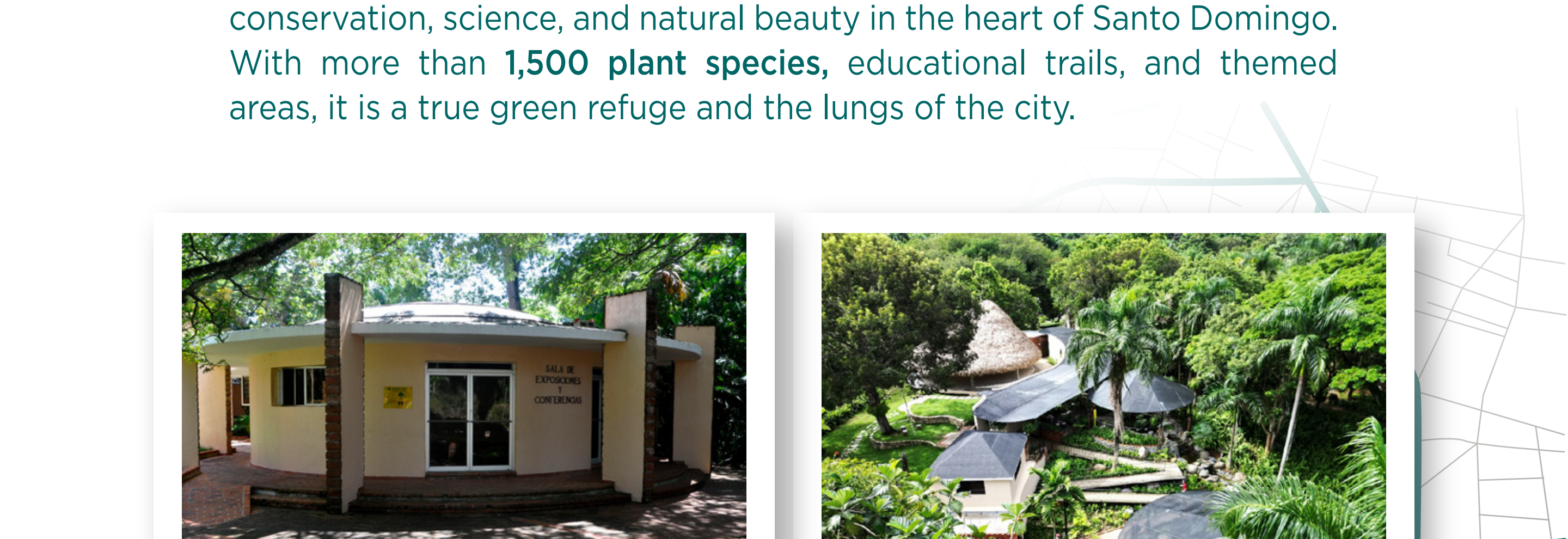

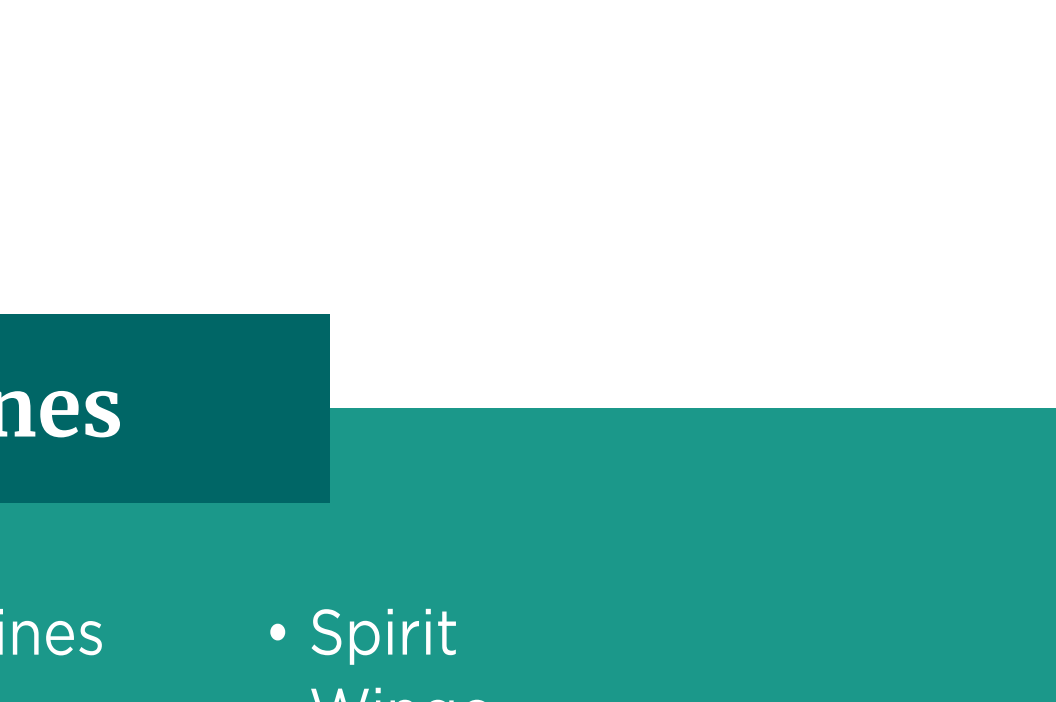

### Las Américas International Airport (SDQ)

Also known as José Francisco Peña Gómez Airport, it is located just 30 minutes from Santo Domingo. It is the main gateway to the capital.

### Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ)

Located about two hours from Santo Domingo, this is the airport with the most international flights in the entire Caribbean.

### President Dr. Joaquín Balaguer International Airport

Dr. Joaquín Balaguer International Airport, also known as "La Isabela International Airport" or "Higüero Airport," is a secondary airport in the city of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

### MODERNITY AND ENTERTAINMENT

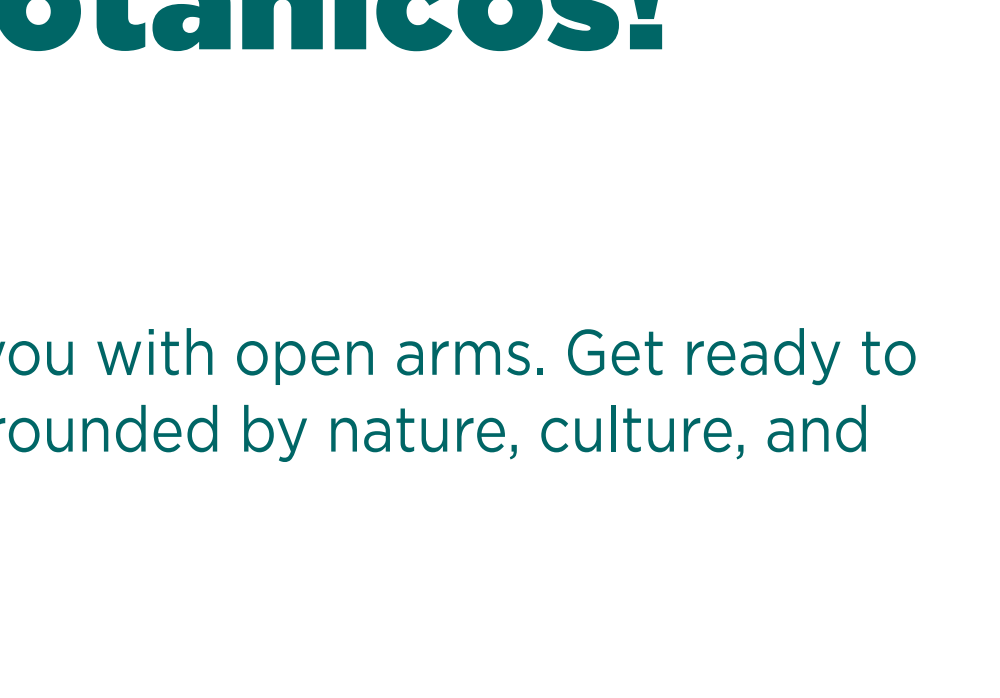
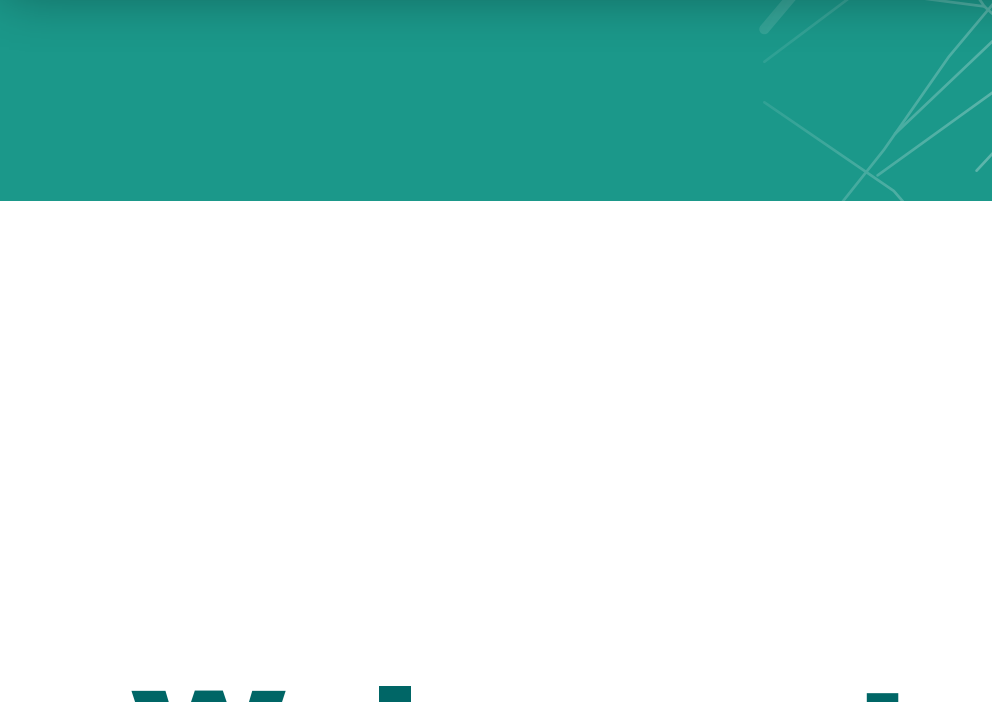

- **Visa, but not if you are coming from:** Mexico, Peru, Ecuador, Chile, Argentina, Colombia, El Salvador, Costa Rica, Puerto Rico, Guatemala, the United States, or Canada.

- Passport valid for at least 6 months.
